MACB Multiple Award Construction Basic Ordering Agreement

Name: Tinker AFB Multiple Award Construction Basic Ordering Agreement (MACB)

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What It Is: The Multiple Award Construction Basic Ordering Agreements (BOA), henceforth known as the MACB, is a written instrument of understanding, negotiated between an agency, contracting activity, or contracting office and a contractor, that contains (1) terms and clauses applying to future contracts (orders) between the parties during its term, (2) a description, as specific as practicable, of supplies or services to be provided, and (3) methods for pricing, issuing, and delivering future orders under the basic ordering agreement. This basic ordering agreement is not a contract. There is not a minimum order guarantee, minimum order amount, or cumulative maximum value, or ceiling associated with the MACB.

How It Works: The PCO will post an annual synopsis of all known and emergent requirements, for 30 days, and issue a subsequent BOA Invitation, which will result in proposals to be evaluated on an acceptable/unacceptable basis with consideration given to technical and past performance factors. This annual synopsis is usually posted in June or July. The Government will evaluate all responses in accordance with the published criteria, and advise each offeror, in writing, whether they will be invited to participate in the resultant acquisition or based on the information submitted if they are unlikely to be a viable competitor (including a general basis for that opinion) which will result in an issuance of multiple BOAs. Each BOA will not exceed a 5 year ordering period IAW Defense Federal Acquisition Regulation Supplement (DFARS) 216.703(c) and must be updated and revalidated at least annually.

The PCO issues competitive Order Proposal Requests (OPRs) for a specific requirement. The synopsis for requirements/orders are not accessible through public information. These are sent out via email to BOA holders. Every project that is implemented on the BOA gets sent to ALL BOA Holders. It is up to them if they want to participate or not. Depending on the magnitude of construction, the OPR will either be solicited as a small business set-aside or full and open competition amongst BOA holders.

Forecast of BOA Requirements: The forecast of BOA requirements list is called the MACB (BOA) Notice of Intent – Annual Synopsis. This synopsis breaks down what will be on the BOA in the upcoming year. This synopsis is on SAM.gov for the duration of the synopsis period. After the allotted time period, all information is closed and inaccessible until the next year.
