| WHEN do I Apply?                                     | Application open season is spring and fall of each year, typically Mar and Oct. It normally runs for 60 days.  |
| WHERE is it Located?                                 | Most courses are available online through Air Force Institute of Technology (AFIT) or Defense Acquistion University (DAU). Some classes are in a classroom setting and may require TDY. The Program Requirements Sheet for each certificate level identifies source of training for each event.  |
| HOW do I Apply?                                      | Eligible employees will complete all program requirements as listed on assigned Requirements Sheet prior to submitting an application to their assigned base POC.
