WHO is Eligible?	Work Leaders assigned to WL duties after 30 Sep 2020. Wage Grade employees with the potential of becoming WLs may volunteer to complete program requirements, but must obtain their 1st Line Supervisor's approval to register.
WHAT is the Opportunity?	WLs are given the opportunity to develop the softskills needed to transition, from mechanic to leader. Program participants complete requirements in a variety of areas such as: Diversity, Goal Setting, Stress Management, Writing Skills, Working with Difficult People, Coaching, Difficult Interactions, Root Cause Analysis, Process Improvement, Blueprint Reading, Art of the Possible, Continuous Process Improvement and Process Management.
WHAT is the Outcome?	WLs obtain the critical knowledge and soft-skills needed to effectively function, in a fluid and agile environment.
WHEN do I Apply?	WLs are automatically enrolled in the program, the month after they are assigned WL duties.
WHERE is it Located?	Most courses are CBT based or completed in a classroom environment. All requirements and event locations are listed on the Command WL Training Template.
HOW do I Apply?	Volunteers must received approval from their 1st Line Supervisor. If approved, the Supervisor will send an approval notification via email to the MWDP Program Manager.
