WHO is Eligible?	All civilians including wage grade employees, with a minimum of 2 years of federal civil service.
WHAT is the Opportunity?	<p>The Air Force CDE is a portfolio of courses and training designed to address the developmental needs of the civilian workforce at all levels. Programs help civilians to achieve short or long term goals at a level appropriate to their needs and desired path of future growth. All programs and opportunities are fully funded by AFPC.</p> <p>View program opportunities, requirements and recommendations on how to select programs at the links below.</p>
WHAT is the Outcome?	Employees who successfully complete programs offered in the CDE program improve their skills in areas critical for the work center, such as team building, problem solving, leadership, conflict resolution and professionalism. Some programs, such as the Civilian Associates Degree Program, result in degrees. A link to CADP is below.
WHERE is it Located?	Training opportunities may occur in person or virtually.
WHEN do I Apply?	Applications are accepted during the annual AFPC CDE open season, typically January thru February of each year.
